Beyond accolades, she breathes life into spaces for young minds through an impactful mural collaboration at a local government school. Rooted in a poignant history, Sarah's artistic journey is enriched by the stories of the Elders in her family, who bore witness to the Stolen Generation and are survivors. Her work is a testament to resilience, echoing the struggles and triumphs of her lineage. With a robust exhibition history, Sarah has showcased her creations in esteemed platforms such as the Kambarang Art exhibition in York and the City of Bayswater Community Art Awards. Beyond accolades, she has contributed to community development by working with government agencies and schools on teambuilding projects.



Deeply committed to fostering creativity within her community, Sarah engages in projects with Indigenous children, imparting cultural wisdom through art. Her dedication extends to designing Derbarl Yerrigan shirts and letterheads for their 50th-anniversary celebration, a testament to her passion for preserving and celebrating Indigenous heritage.

In Aboriginal culture, the land was created and given life through the journeys of the 'Spirit Ancestors' during the period called the 'Dreamtime' or 'Dreaming'. The 'Spirit Ancestors' are symbolised by animals which are the sacred totem animal of a tribal group. Each clan family belonging to the group is responsible for the protection and care of their sacred totem animal. The artworks featured in Huhtamaki's range of cups illustrate the tribe area and their sacred totem animals.





Goanna Artwork

Each dotted circle represents a clan, all of these clans are connected by tracks (dotted lines). The Goanna is the sacred totem animal of the tribe and it is protected from being hunted within this area. If the Goanna travels beyond these tracks then he can be hunted.

Dolphin Artwork

The three circles around the artwork represent seaside tribes that run along the ocean, the dotted lines are the tracks from one tribe to the next. The Dolphin illustrated in the centre of the artwork is their sacred totem animal. The Indigenous people of these clans will never hunt the dolphins, they will swim and co-exist with them.
