## NAPKINS -TYPES OF FOLDS

Napkin folds significantly impact the overall design, atmosphere, and visual appeal of your event and provide you with an opportunity to bring additional, practical details into your place setting. They are a great way to add a touch of elegance to a table setting, even for casual events. They come in various styles, and each fold serves different purposes, whether for practical use or decorative appeal.

Whether you're hosting a formal dinner, a casual gathering, or a special celebration, the right napkin fold can elevate the experience, making it more organised, professional, and memorable for your guests.



The "GT" in "GT fold" typically stands for "Grand Towel" or "Grand Table", referring to its elegant and structured appearance. GT dinner napkins are folded 8 times to be tall and thick, with embossing on the edge. They are ideal for restaurant/formal situations, because they give a neat structured look to a table setting.

### **Quarter Fold**

A quarter-fold napkin is folded into four equal sections, usually creating a small square or rectangle shape. This fold is often used for disposable napkins in both casual and formal settings due to its simplicity and practicality. 1/4 fold design ensures a clean, polished presentation for any occasion, suitable for all purposes. Great for cafes, caterers and events. **Available in Kraft and White.** 





#### **Compact Fold**

Compact fold dispenser napkins are an industry standard napkin most often seen in cafes in napkin dispensers. Ideal for most food services, as they are easy for dispensing, minimising waste and ensuring hygienic handling. A compact fold napkin (often called a neat fold or simple fold) refers to a straightforward, compact fold with the ability to keep the napkin small and neat, while still presenting a well-organised look. **Available in Kraft and White.** 



### **Tall Fold/Long Fold**

A tall fold napkin is a style of folding disposable napkins where the napkin is folded into a long, vertical shape. This fold creates a tall, narrow structure. often used in banquet-style events where napkins need to be organised efficiently but still appear decorative. **Available in White.** 



#### V Fold/Interfold

A V fold napkin (also known as an interfolded napkin) is a type of disposable napkin fold where the napkins are folded so that each napkin is slightly "interlocked" with the one below it, creating a neat, organised stack of napkins. This folding style ensures that each napkin is easily accessible and can be pulled from the stack without disturbing the others. In the interfold style, napkins are designed to be dispensed one at a time, which is particularly useful in environments where guests need to grab a napkin quickly, like at buffets or self-service stations.
